

Roll Off Dumpster Terms and Conditions

Roll Off Capacity: The District will determine the appropriate roll off container based on the waste disposal indicated on the application. **Special conditions:** For disposal of heavy items such as concrete, asphalt, shingles or dirt, roll off container shall be **no more than 50% full**. If container is overfilled, customer shall be responsible for removal of excess debris.

Rental Period: Roll off container rental period is 7-days. The District will automatically schedule removal of a roll off one week after it was delivered, on the same day of the week. Please call to schedule early removal. No rental period extension is available.

Fees: The rental fee of \$229.82 will not be prorated. Following approval of the site, completion of the application and payment of fees, the roll off will be scheduled for delivery on the next regular business day, or based on availability as discussed prior to rental. Roll off fees include 3 tons of disposal. Additional weight at time of disposal may be subject to additional fees.

Property Damage: The District is not liable for damage to property due to placing or removing a container. Roll off sites must be approved by the District and confirmed by the customer before a container is placed, therefore all liability of damage is placed with the customer. It is the customer's responsibility to locate all water lines, sewage pipes, gas lines, electrical lines, septic systems, and any other infrastructure that may be damaged by the placement and/or removal of a container. The District shall not be responsible for damage to any private pavement or accompanying subsurface to lawn, concrete, asphalt or any route reasonably necessary to perform the services herein contracted.

Prohibited Items: The following items are prohibited from being placed in a container. Federal, state and county law/regulation require special handling and disposal of the following items. A fee may be assessed or the item may be left with the customer if any of the below items are found in the container upon removal.

| Prohibited Item | Examples (including but not limited to) |
|---------------------------|---|
| Asbestos Containing Items | Slate siding, insulation, fiberboards, tiles, pipe and duct insulations or any other items made from asbestos. |
| Batteries | Lead acid batteries, bulk disposal of household batteries, or electronics containing rechargeable batteries. |
| Bulk Liquids | Drums of fluid, full or partially filled paint cans, etc. |
| Chemicals | Motor oil, coolant, cleaning products, etc. |
| Electronics | TVs, DVD players, cell phones, computers, speakers, tablets, etc. |
| Explosives | Gun powder, oxidizers, propane tanks, spray paint cans, etc. |
| Flammable Materials | Gasoline, lighter fluid, paint thinner, lacquer, oil-based paint etc. |
| Hazardous Wastes | Acids, bases, organics, oxidizers, pesticides, paints, organic solvents, radioactive waste, and medical supplies. |
| Medical Wastes | Bandages, syringes, band-aids, deceased animals, etc. |
| Tires and Wheels | Any type of wheel or tire. |
