

Water Conservation Incentive Program

Toilet Replacement

Water billing credit is available to participating water customers who replace existing toilet(s) of 1.6 GPF or greater. Limit 2 toilet replacement credits per property. Two rebate levels are available:

1. \$50.00: Existing toilet of 1.6 GPF replaced with one using ≤ 1.28 GPF.
 2. \$100.00: Existing toilet of greater than 1.6 GPF replaced with one using ≤ 1.28 GPF.
- * Highest flush rating will be used for eligibility on existing or new dual flush toilet(s).

Application Requirements:

- Complete rebate request below and agree to terms and conditions on the reverse.
- Photos before toilets(s) are removed and after the toilet(s) are replaced. Applications with incomplete or missing photos will not qualify for a rebate.
- Submit application, photos, and proof of purchase in person or electronically to kjohnson@bbccsd.org.

Pictures Required Before Toilet(s) are removed:

- A front-view photo of existing toilet and surrounding area as proof of location.
- Legible photo(s) of the make, model and year of production. You can locate this information on the inside of the toilet’s tank.
- A photo of the GPF rate of the old toilet. The GPF is typically stamped by the manufacturer on the inside of the toilet tank, between the toilet seat and the tank, or underneath the tank lid.

Pictures Required After Toilet(s) are replaced:

- A front-view photo of the new toilet(s) in the same location as the replaced toilet for verification of installation.
- A photo of the GPF rate of the new toilet. The GPF is typically stamped by the manufacturer on the inside of the toilet tank, between the toilet seat and the tank, or underneath the tank lid.
- A photo or copy of the receipt/invoice as proof of purchase.

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Toilet Replacement Terms & Conditions

- Funds are limited; rebates will be issued on a first come, first served basis until rebate funds are depleted.
- Incomplete applications, including incomplete or illegible photos or receipt will not be approved for rebate.
- Rebates will be issued upon receipt of complete application, photos, and proof of purchase. Submission of an incomplete application does not guarantee rebate funds will be available upon completion of all program requirements.
- The customer owns and is solely responsible for the purchase, use, handling, installation, and maintenance of all devices.
- No replacement devices or rebates will be issued by the CSD for broken or defective devices. The CSD makes no warranty that devices will function as advertised.
- Neither District, nor its contractors or agents, makes any representation or warranty regarding the contracted services or products that project participant may select for its project under the program. Installation of water efficient toilets does not guarantee reduced water use. Any and all claims or causes of action program participants may have in connection with any defect or failure of performance of any contracted service or installed toilet may only be pursued with the contractor the participant hired or the appropriate manufacturer/distributor.
- By participating in the program and accepting the rebates provided, program participants thereby release District, its contractors and agents, from any and all claims and causes of action that may arise out of the purchase, installation, and/or use of water efficient toilets in connection with the program.
- District may use pre and post conversion photos for reproduction or promotional purposes. Identification location features, such as address numbers, will not be included in any promotional materials.
- Program participants are responsible for ensuring that their projects comply with all applicable Federal, State, County, local laws, District rules and regulations, as well as applicable CC&Rs and/or HOA restrictions.
- Quality of work and appearance of the project area are the responsibility of the participant.
- Further, program participants agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the District, its directors, officers, employees, contractors, and agents, from all liability and claims of any kind arising out of, or related to, program participant's purchase, installation, and use of water efficient toilets in connection with this program.
